<i>Is this a policy rather than a program?</i>	Does it complement programmatic work and allow programs to flourish as a result of this policy? Does it include enforcement?	
<i>Is this policy legally feasible?</i>	Does it meet constitutional standards? How do you know? How might you find out?	
<i>Is there data or evidence to support the policy?</i>	Is there a connection between the policy and the problem? What data or research makes the case? Can you create local data, too?	
<i>Is the implementation clear and feasible?</i>	What are barriers to implementation? Is the implementation process clear? Are there stakeholders who could help?	

<p><i>Does the policy account for disparities?</i></p>	<p>If yes, can you strengthen this impact? If no, how can you improve it?</p>	
<p><i>Is this policy financially sustainable?</i></p>	<p>Is there existing money? Could the policy generate revenue? Is it low-cost or no-cost? Is it self-implementing?</p>	
<p><i>Does the policy “change the conversation”?</i></p>	<p>Does the policy change the conversation? If no, how could it?</p>	
<p><i>Is the policy part of a bigger plan?</i></p>	<p>What is the bigger plan? How does this policy fit in?</p>
